## Other Health Disabilities: Assessment Planning Requirements

Other Health Disability (OHD) means having limited strength, endurance, vitality, or alertness, including a heightened or diminished alertness to environmental stimuli, with respect to the educational environment that is due to a broad range of medically diagnosed chronic or acute health conditions that adversely affect a pupil's educational performance.

For both initial and reevaluation, the eligibility determination must be supported by either current or existing data from the information provided above. If the team has existing data (e.g., an achievement test completed by an outside agency), the team may use that data if it is considered current, and a valid reflection of the student's current skills.
